Working Journalist Definition

(as defined by the National Press Club, Washington DC)

Working journalists are defined as:

Working as a:

- · Reporter, editor, writer, publisher
- Editorial or news cartoonist or artist
- News photographer or videographer
- Producer, president or general manager
- Librarian, web master or other editorial employee

For a publication, news service, broadcast outlet or Internet site that is:

- Regularly issued
- Supported by advertising or paid subscriptions or published or funded by a non-profit organization
- Operated with editorial independence from any political, governmental, commercial, or special interest group
- · Not a house organ of any organization or movement
- Published primarily for the dissemination of news

Teach journalism at the college level as their primary professional activity and are an instructor, professor or dean.

Are principally a non-fiction author whose work has been published by a commercial printing house.
